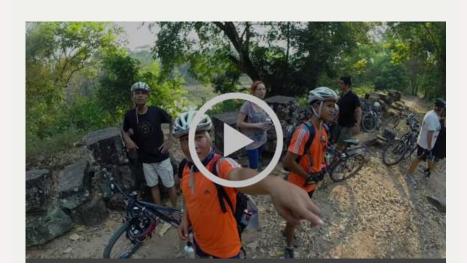


Phnom Penh, 23rd of April 2018

LAO - CAMBODIA adventure circuit:

Embark on a new 5-day trek that ascends Laos' third highest mountain, Phou Louey the "Forever Mountain" (Elev. 2,257m). It is one of the few cloud forests in the region. This trek through the evergreen forest includes a homestay in a Khmu village at the start of the tour, followed by a camping in jungle huts inside the protected area, and The (hanging) Nests and wildlife observation tower.
